- **Segregation of students with migration background in comprehensive schools: equity and free choice dilemmas**

The **solution-generating sessions** will use creative thinking techniques and scenario method to arrive at innovative solutions for two areas of migration/ education policy issues:

- **Segregation, self-segregation and marginalisation: the search for new solutions**
- **Setting up policies for the education of migrants where there were none before**
